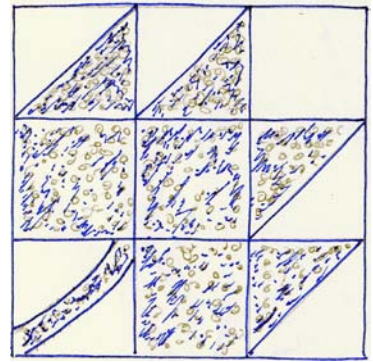


MAPLE LEAF BLOCK

The blocks will be made into a quilt (or two) for our wounded soldiers.

Two sizes of 9 patch blocks can be made.

4 of the smaller blocks can be put together to form a larger block. Each block is made up of 9 squares.



LARGE BLOCK: 9" finished - $9\frac{1}{2}$ " square unfinished. Make using 9 - $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares:

SMALL BLOCK: $4\frac{1}{2}$ " finished - 5" square unfinished. Make using 9 - 2" squares:

Each block is made up of the following $3\frac{1}{2}$ " or 2" squares:

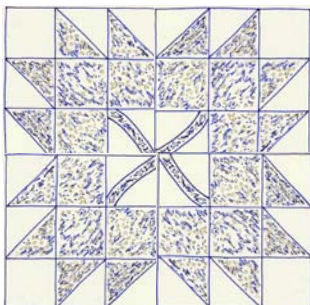
- 4 half-square triangles - light and leaf colour
- 3 squares - leaf colour
- 2 squares - light color; 1 stem piece appliquéd onto 1 light square.
Stem piece is 1" wide and the length of the diagonal of the square used.

Half-square triangles can be made in any method you prefer.

Leaf colours can be any colour.

The background preferred is a white on white, but a cream on cream can also be used.

Stem can be appliquéd or it can be stitched into the triangle.
